- We experiment with exercise styles and targets. We challenge ourselves to create exercises that appeal to different intelligences; e.g. musical, kinaesthetic or intrapersonal intelligences. In addition to the aforementioned mathematical / logical and linguistic intelligences.
- As learning facilitators it is our responsibility to point out unjust and/or discriminatory structures and to strive towards safer learning environments. Particularly for people affected by structural discrimination.

- Everybody deals and copes differently with weaknesses or features commonly regarded as such.
- We don't play favourites and try to host both well adapted learners and the ones who might struggle. At the same time it is of great importance to us to host ourselves.

We avoid stereotypes and stereotyping in regards to gender, race, age, capability, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation and identity, culture, ... For us this is a work in progress. There is no ultimate goal or final level of 'perfection'.
