The Project

Covid-19 put the world up-side-down für the whole training market. We all – as trainers and educators – had a big learning curve in creating online trainings, as many of our courses and seminars were transferred to online.

Through the discussions about our experiences in these online trainings, we realized that we all were missing "informal moments", where we had a chat about the training, but also about many other topics. We missed these breaks in between, where we could – as learners – digest the learnings, relax among friends and colleagues and maybe have the most phantastic ideas about a future projects.

We decided to take up this topic and created and **Erasmus+ project** with the following goals:

- discuss with other adult educators what "informal moments" are
- look into **research** about "informal moments"
- **test methods** for online and off-line "informal moments"
- write a publication with a framework on how we as trainers and educators can create "informal moments" online and offline

We are looking for **adult educators**, who want to explore and reflect with us the topics of "**informal moments**" and have experience as a trainer with one of the following **target groups**:

- LGBTQI+
- Migration
- Unemployed people

What we offer

We invite you to research with us and take part in an on-site 3-day event (in English), where we have several training sessions with informal moments in between. We will ask you for your active participation and for your reflection – personally and on a meta-level.

One of the outputs of the project is a "Framework for information moments – online and offline". The main topics we will develop together with you in the event. Following the training we ask you to apply some informal moments in in your training and working environment and to share your experiences with us.

Your commitment

- Full participation in the event in Wiener Neustadt (Austria) from 13 15 of September 2022
- Test (at least once) informal moments in your working surrounding in the period between September and December 2022
- Take part in one online event, where we exchange the outcomes (date to be decided together)

Financial frame

We offer a lump sum for the travel expenses and will take care of accommodation (4 nights) and food during the 3-day seminar period.

The amount of your travel allowance depends on the **distance**, (see calculator of Erasmus+: https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/resources-and-tools/distance-calculator), and the sustainability of the trip ("green travel"). In principle, train travel is considered sustainable. Air travel is possible in principle and will also be subsidised by the funding body, but at a lower amount.

Travel allowance:

- 0-100 km the train costs will be reimbursed
- 100-499 km sustainable journey rail: allowance € 210.
- 100-499 km standard trip e.g. aeroplane: allowance € 180,-
- 500-1999 km sustainable journey by train: subsidy € 320,-.
- 500-1999 km standard journey e.g. by plane: subsidy € 275,-.
